Peer Tutoring

What is Peer Tutoring?

Peer tutoring is available to students needing more one-on-one support, in some of Augsburg's lower demand courses. Tutors work with the student(s) to arrange tutoring times where specific questions can be addressed. Peer tutors are trained to model important study skill habits and to assist students through open ended questioning. Tutoring does not replace important class time, nor professor support; instead it provides an additional avenue of support for students who may need more one-on-one assistance.

Peer tutors are model students who have done well in the course and have been recognized by faculty as having the skills to tutor their peers.
