We hope you enjoy your time at Augsburg College. Below you will find community resources for transportation, food, and neighborhood services. You will also find information on some of the discounts and perks for Augsburg faculty and staff.

Transportation

Metro Transit Bus & Light Rail Information: The closest light rails stations to campus are the Franklin blue line station, the Cedar Riverside blue line station, and the University of Minnesota green line station. A number of bus routes pass by the campus or within a few blocks of campus. For more information visit www.metrotransit.org to view schedules or to plan your trip. Parking Permits on campus: Parking in campus lots requires a permit year round 24 hours per day. Log into Inside Augsburg and select "Parking Services" on the left to register for a parking permit. Street Parking: Some public street parking is available without a permit, but may be limited to one-hour or four-hour increments. The city of Minneapolis actively monitors the street parking and tickets regularly.

Augsburg ID Cards

ID cards are made in Lindell Library during regular business hours at the circulation desk. The Augsburg ID will enable you to gain access to a variety of benefits such as:

- Faculty/Staff Discount at the Augsburg Barnes and Noble Bookstore
- Free admission to Augsburg sponsored athletic events
- Access to the gym in the Kennedy Center
- Ability to check out materials from Augsburg or any CLIC library
- Additionally many retail and restaurants offer discounts to Augsburg faculty and staff, so keep your ID handy and be sure to ask if a discount is available.

Perks

403(b) Payroll Contributions: All faculty and staff are eligible to make pretax payroll contributions to the 403(b) plan. The plan is through TIAA and may be started or stopped at any time. Contact Human Resources for more information on how to participate.

Daily Chapel: Daily chapel service is a time for ecumenical reflection rooted in our Lutheran tradition. Faculty and staff are asked to respect chapel times and not schedule regular standing meetings during Chapel times.

Mail on Campus: Mail & Shipping is located on the lower level of Christensen Center behind the Copy Center. The mailroom is open 9 a.m.-4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. You can buy stamp singles, books, and rolls. You can also mail or ship your personal packages.

Theatre Performances: Tickets for Augsburg College Theatre Department productions are discounted for faculty and staff. For more information call the box office at 612-330-1257. A schedule of theatre performances is available at <http://www.augsburg.edu/theatre>.

Music Events: Most performances by Augsburg groups or soloists are free to faculty and staff. Performances by off-campus groups are often discounted. Contact the music department at 612-330-1265. A schedule of music events is available at <http://www.augsburg.edu/music>.

Athletic Events: Faculty and staff may attend regular season athletic events at no cost if the employee shows a valid Augsburg College ID card.

Fitness Center: Faculty and staff may use work out facilities during regular hours of operation. Hours are generally Mon. thru Fri. 6:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m., Sat. 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., and Sun. 12:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. Times may be adjusted during holidays and breaks.

Library: Faculty and Staff have full privileges at the Augsburg Library as well as any CLIC Library. CLIC libraries include Augsburg, Bethel, Concordia-St. Paul, Hamline University and the Hamline Law Library, Macalester, the University of St. Thomas, and the College of St. Catherine (St. Paul and Minneapolis campuses). You must have a valid Augsburg College ID Card with a bar code.

Bookstore: Augsburg College faculty and staff may receive a discount of 20% at the Augsburg College Bookstore. The discount excludes health & beauty, convenience items, software, and textbooks.

Wells Fargo Banks: Membership Banking provides special banking benefits that have been arranged for you with Wells Fargo banks. A Wells Fargo Home Mortgage program is also available.
