Provost's Internationalization Travel Grant Call for Proposals 2018 Due February 15, 2018

Proposals will be due on February 15th, or the following Monday if it lands on a weekend, of each year.

Two travel grants of up to \$2,500 will be awarded annually to faculty interested in pursuing teaching, research, curriculum development /integration, or other scholarly collaboration with an Augsburg CGEE Global Site or with an existing international partner institution.*

Ideally, the travel grants will be awarded annually for projects in two different regions of the world.

- Africa CGEE Global Site in Namibia, a CGEE local university or NGO partner in Namibia and South Africa
- Asia Augsburg exchange partner universities in China (2), Hong Kong, Japan, South Korea (2), or a CGEE NGO partner in Myanmar
- **Europe** Augsburg exchange partner universities in Finland, Germany, Greece, Norway, Slovenia and the UK (England).
- Latin America CGEE Global Sites in Costa Rica, El Salvador, Guatemala, Mexico, and Nicaragua, or through a CGEE local university or NGO partner.
- Middle East Augsburg exchange partner universities in Lebanon and Palestinian Territories

PURPOSE

To provide support for faculty to pursue international teaching, research, or other scholarly collaboration with Augsburg University international programs or partner institutions. The program is designed to achieve three outcomes:

- 1) Develop faculty international knowledge, experience, and relationships for internationalizing the campus and the curriculum.
- Strengthen the relationship and collaboration between Augsburg University and its CGEE Global Sites and partners.*
- 3) Support Faculty Intercultural Development.
- * While the goal of the grants is to strengthen existing relationships, innovative proposals that work toward the development of new international partnerships will be considered.
