

Fine Arts Scholarship

VISUAL ARTS

The **Fine Arts Scholarship in Visual Arts** recognizes incoming students who have excelled in studio arts and who plan to actively participate in the visual arts at Augsburg.

This award is worth **\$3,000*** per year and is based on an on-campus portfolio presentation and personal interview.

To be considered for a Fine Arts Scholarship in Visual Arts:

1. Schedule an interview and portfolio presentation. Interviews are by appointment for spring semester or during Scholarship Weekend, February 22-23, 2008, for fall semester.
2. Complete the enclosed application form.
3. Include a personal résumé and personal statement with your completed application.
4. Write a 250-word essay on the following topic: "Tell us about a time your artwork made a difference to you and how it engaged a community."
5. Include a completed recommendation form with your application.
6. Include a portfolio of 10-12 original art works, presented in CD, DVD, or slide format.

DO NOT send actual original art works. Advance documentation is preferred, but actual original art works can be brought to the interview if you cannot provide digital formatting or slides in advance. For digital work samples, files must be sent on a Macintosh-compatible CD-ROM in JPEG format. Each file should be named with the artist's surname and a number that corresponds to an identification sheet (example: Smith_01). Images should be at least 72 dpi in resolution and not larger than 3 MB per image.

Applicants need not major in visual arts, but are required to participate in various exhibits, Art Club, and other departmental activities. Applicants may apply for the Fine Arts Scholarship in theatre, music, film, and visual arts, but may receive only one scholarship.

* The \$3,000 award is available to those entering Augsburg during the 08-09 school year. Students starting spring term of the 07-08 school year are eligible for a \$2,500 award.
