## **COURSE REGISTRATION INFORMATION**

Students who are participating as full-time students should take 3-4 courses, and no more than four. Please review the courses for your program on the following pages, then complete and sign your registration form and return it to our Minneapolis office. Please keep a copy for your records. You will be registered for courses based on this form. Any changes to your registration must be made in writing, whether this is before or after the program starts. You are responsible for knowing what classes you signed up for, and submitting any changes in writing to the Minneapolis Office or the International Program Coordinators.

You need fill in only your name, social security number and course selections. Your Augsburg identification number will be provided by the Center for Global Education office in Minneapolis.

All courses are offered with two grading options:

- Traditional grading (T) on a 4.0 to 0.0 scale
- Pass/No Credit (P/N) P means a grade of 2.0 or better, and N means no credit and a grade of less than 2.0.

**Students may only select the P/NC option if it has been approved by the home school**. Some schools will not accept Pass/No Credit grades as transfer credit, and grade options cannot be changed after the program is completed. A signed authorization from your home school is required.
