

## Minneapolis College Approved Courses for Communication Studies

For students planning to transfer to Augsburg University and major in Communication Studies, the following major equivalencies are provided. The Communication Studies major consists of twelve courses, including a required core of nine courses and three electives chosen with the help of a faculty advisor. **For transfer students, at least six of twelve major requirements must be taken at Augsburg.**
