^{*}These credits can be transfer credits from other colleges, or additional transfer credits outside the AFA program from North Hennepin. If a student does not have additional transfer credits, the student should consider using these credits to add a minor or double major (ex. Literature, Language, Theory; Film; Communication Studies; New Media; Art). Students may choose to add individual courses for personal interest as an option (ex. Book Arts, Film Direction, Web Design).

Advising Notes:

- ENGL2450 Survey of American Literature I and ENGL2460 Survey of American Literature II will transfer in together as an upper-division major elective in literature, ENL352 American Literature from 1900 – 1945.
- ENGL2550 Survey of British Literature I and ENGL2560 Survey of British Literature II will transfer in together as an upper-division major elective in literature, ENL336 Age of Victoria.
- Students who do not complete the MnTC may have to complete additional degree requirements at Augsburg.
- In addition to completing a major, students need to complete the Core Curriculum and earn at least 128 credits. Residency policy requires that students complete at least 32 credits at Augsburg, with at least 24 of the last 32 credits in residence.
