Rachel (Selle) McLaughlin graduated from Augsburg College in 2001 with a BA in biology. She earned her MD from Loma Linda University in California and then went on to complete a four-year residency in obstetrics and gynecology at St. Joseph Mercy Hospital in Ann Arbor, Mich. Rachel has long been interested in medical missions and international work. She took her first missions trip to Mexico while in college and has since served at hospitals in Cambodia, Swaziland, and Bangladesh. She and her husband, Eric (a family practice doctor), have spent the last two years working at Tenwek Hospital in western Kenya through the ministry of Samaritan's Purse. They are part of a team of six doctors from their home church in Ann Arbor who feel called to pursue missions as a community of believers. While in Kenya, it became clear that God was calling them to work long-term in the country of Burundi on staff at a brand new Christian medical school. Burundi has only 300 doctors for 10 million people, and Rachel is excited to be a part of training new doctors. She returned from Kenya in September and hopes to return to Burundi by 2013.
