

Moving from a Division-Based Model of General Education to an Outcomes-Based Model:

Courses fulfilling LAAP requirements will need to demonstrate the outcomes and other specified criteria for that LAAP. Regular review and assessment will ensure quality. While faculty will find greater latitude to propose courses for various Gen Ed requirements, we also anticipate that certain divisions will provide the bulk of courses for some requirements. Here is a (very) rough approximation of where we anticipate divisions contributing the most LAAP courses:
