Paul S. Mueller, MD is a staff consultant and the chair of the Division of General Internal Medicine at Mayo Clinic in Rochester, Minn. He is a professor of medicine and a professor of biomedical ethics in the Mayo Clinic College of Medicine. After graduating from Augsburg College in 1984, he went on to earn his medical degree and master of public health degree from the Johns Hopkins University. Mueller is an internationally recognized scholar in biomedical ethics, and has been recognized as a “Top Internist” by U.S. News and World Report. He was elected to the Augsburg Board of Regents in 2005, for which he now serves as chair.
