

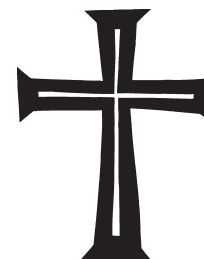
## ANNOUNCEMENTS

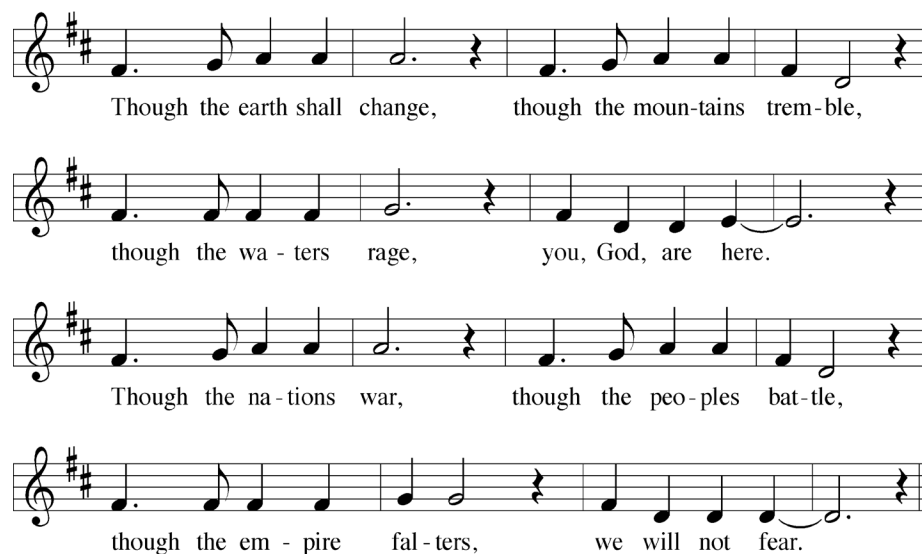
