And wisdom of the soul become one."

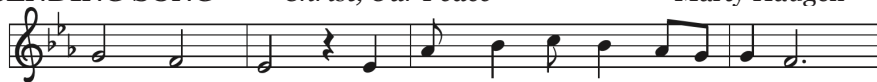
