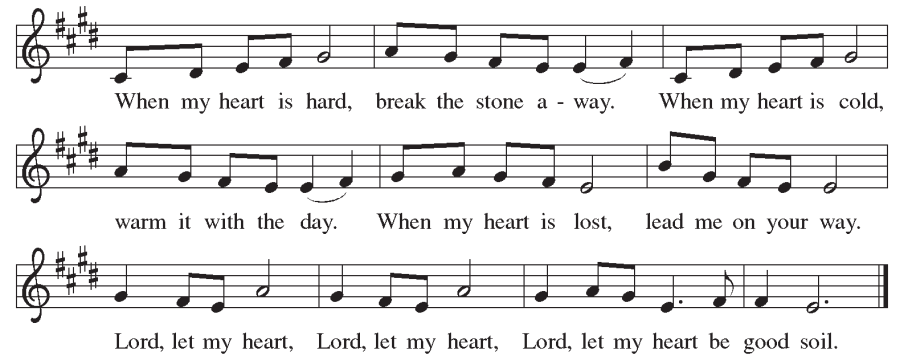
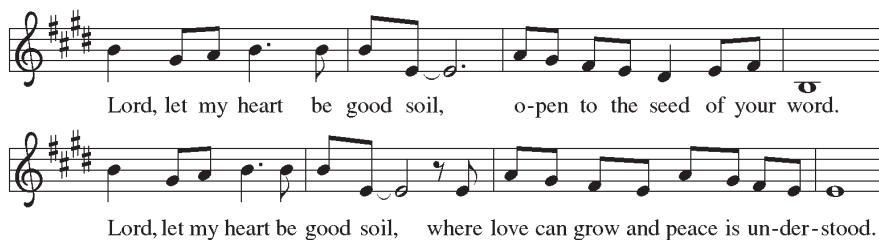
SCRIPTURE READING Romans 12:9-21 The Inclusive Bible
