Car Sharing

There are several car sharing programs available and convenient to the entire Twin Cities Metro area. There is an HourCar parked on-campus, in its own space, which can be reserved by the hour or by the day. For one-way trips, car2go is integrated into Minneapolis City Parking, so you find one using their website or app, pick it up, and then leave it parked at your destination in street parking or car2go designated spots. Both programs are easy to sign up for online, and have a variety of payment options, usually requiring a small annual fee plus a charge-by-the-mile system for travel.

Carpooling

Carpool permits are available to groups of 2 or more faculty and staff, or commuter students, who commit to bringing only one car to campus at a time. Faculty/staff in the carpool group share the cost of one permit and will receive a reserved parking space for their carpool group in Lot G, behind the CCHP house. Biking in the Twin Cities

How To Register

Log into Augnet and click
 "Parking Services" on the left

- Update your contact and vehicle info (license, make, model, color, year)
 - Click "P" for Parking
 - Select your permit type
 - Select & enter your payment information
- Any outstanding violation payments will have to be made before you can pick up your permit
- Permits will be available for pick up from DPS in the Urn/Mort lobby 2 business days after payment has been processed. Bring a photo id!
- Make sure your info (license plate & cell phone number) is up to date! If we run into issues we'll call you, so make sure the phone number is accurate.

- -.51 .74 FTE , **\$168** for the semester, **\$336** for the year (\$42 per month with Payroll deduction)

Interim Permits

Purchased a hang-tag parking permit? Awesome. Don't have it with you today? No problem! Come to the DPS dispatch window located in the Urn/Mort lobby and staffed 24/7 and ask for an interim permit.

The dispatcher will ask for a photo id to confirm the valid status of your parking permit. Then they will be able to make up a paper hang-tag Interim permit for you to use.

Interim permits work just like your usual permit, so park in the same lots. Permits holders can receive up to 3 Interim permits a year, after that a \$5 Temporary permit will have to be purchased.

Temporary Permits

Daily or short-term Temporary permits are available for if you have a car on campus once in a while, or for a short period of time. Temporary permits cost \$5 a day and are registered online. You can pay and print from home, or make an exact cash or check payment at the DPS window.
