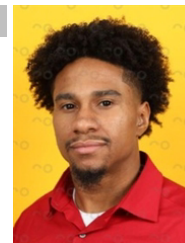

Narrative text

On Monday January 16th, at approximately 10:30 hours, I Officer Peterson was contacted by DPS dispatch who informed me that a student at dispatch had their vehicle broken into and wanted to file a report.
