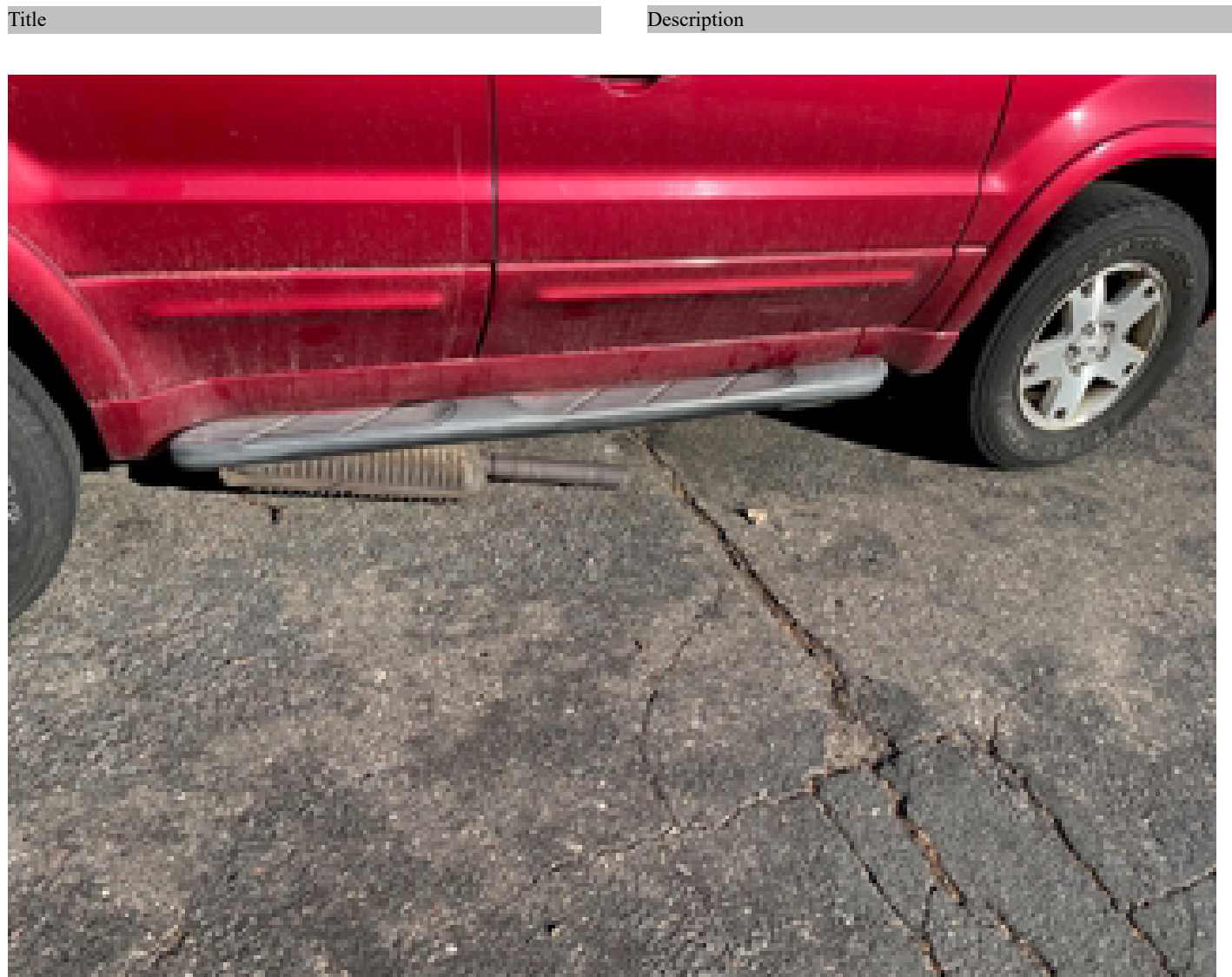

**Narrative text**

AAJ9874 - Catalytic converter stolen off vehicle.

Myself and 150 saw a large group of people in MURPHY park and questioned some. No one witnessed anyone damaging vehicle but said thirty minutes before our arrival they saw MPD out speaking to what they believed to be an owner of the one of the vehicles. At this time we had dispatch attempt contact with staff in athletics in case any people who were visiting for the game were the owners of any of the vehicles. Dispatch was unable to get ahold of any.

Myself and 150 took vehicle information and checked campus for any more damaged vehicles.

I had 150 take vehicle information to dispatch to check our system if any vehicles were registered to students. Only one vehicle was registered in our system (BWZ203) but not under a students name. It was towed out of Lot D on 9/20/2022.

As of reporting no owners have come to report the damages to their vehicles.
