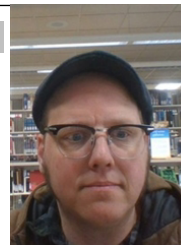

**Narrative text**

On 4/5/2023 at approximately 1445 I Officer HARTKOPF (127) was doing a routine vehicle patrol when I noticed two younger looking individuals walking down Butler westbound. Before I was able to call it in, dispatch informed me that there was a report of two individuals looking into vehicles on Butler. I was unable to get closer to the individuals or the vehicle they drove off in due to heavy traffic. At the time MYERS-LEEHEY, BLAIR was present and witnessed the flee. They fled in a silver Kia sedan with its passenger rear window broken. MYERS-LEEHEY notified me that they left items behind when running away, a wallet and an Apple watch. In the wallet there was an ID for an individual who is not in our system as being associated with Augsburg in any way. MPD was notified.

When MPD squad #122 arrived the watch and the wallet were turned over to them. The officer explained that the hospital also reported the same group of people driving around attempting to steal vehicles there. While taking the report the same group now was driving around North Minneapolis and attempted to ram a police vehicle.
