## Narrative text

On 03/04/2023 at approximately 1529 hours, I Officer Staley was dispatched to the area of 6th street and 21st ave for a report of 7 to 8 kids attempting to steal a vehicle. I arrived in the area at approximately 1531 hours and observed a silver sedan occupied several times.

I pulled up along side the vehicle and the vehicle started to drive off but stopped. I then observed a young male running down the sidewalk towards the silver sedan.

I put my vehicle in park and attempted to apprehend the subject. While doing so the individual jumped in the back passenger side window head first leaving his legs out the window. I grabbed his legs and was drug about 30-40 feet down 6th street before coming to a stop and the vehicle continued down 6th street.

I radioed dispatch and informed them of what happened at which time Officer Hartkopf arrived on scene and requested EMS to respond to check me out.

While waiting for EMS and MPD to arrive Director Harri arrived on scene.

At approximately 1555 hours HCMC #447 arrived and checked me over and I was released.

MPD arrived on scene as well as the owner of the car that was attempted to be stolen MPD took the report and evidence.

Officers and MPD went back to the office and retained video coverage.







## **Narrative text**

On 3/4/2023 at approximately 1529 I Officer HARTKOPF (127) and Officer STALEY (150) were dispatched to what a caller believed to be a ground of people attempting to steal a vehicle. The caller stated it was a large group of people that were all in one vehicle originally but are in the vehicle they are attempting to steal. 150, being in the squad, arrived first. As I was running north on 21st when 150 aired that he was drug behind a vehicle. I found 150 and assessed him briefly. 150 was able to stand and walk with a slight limp. 150 stated that he did not hit his head and did not show any signs that he hit his head. I told 150 to stay on the stolen vehicle while I attempt to check the area for the vehicle. At this time I informed dispatch to call MPD but also have EMS come out and check on 150.

When driving around I did not see the vehicle in the immediate area.

I returned to 150 and aided him into the patrol squad. Director HARRI also arrived on the scene at this time. I had 150 remove his duty belt and informed dispatch that he would be out of service until cleared by EMS. 150 stated that he rolled three times after letting go of the individual hanging out of the car. 150 had an abrasion to his left knee, and complained of

hip pain on his left side. Later in the call he began complaining of back pain. When reviewing 150's recollection of the event, it appeared he was dragged approximately 30-40 feet.

EMS arrived and cleared 150 at this time.

MPD arrived and we explained the situation. As MPD was there taking information about the attempted theft the owner, HELB, VERONICA arrived. HELB, and Augsburg student was informed of the situation and MPD collected evidence from the vehicle. A black tennis shoe was left behind and a screw driver was left in the center console.

MPD asked for the camera footage of the incident. Myself and 150 returned to the office and retrieved the footage for him. A copy is saved for our records.
