



Narrative text

On 4/5/2023 at approximately 1445 I Officer HARTKOPF (127) was doing a routine vehicle patrol when I noticed two younger looking individuals walking down Butler westbound. Before I was able to call it in, dispatch informed me that there was a report of two individuals looking into vehicles on Butler. I was unable to get closer to the individuals or the vehicle they drove off in due to heavy traffic. At the time MYERS-LEEHY, BLAIR was present and witnessed the flee. They fled in a silver Kia sedan with its passenger rear window broken. MYERS-LEEHY notified me that they left items behind when running away, a wallet and an Apple watch.
