

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



## **Narrative text**

On 10/21/2022 at approximately 1308 I Officer HARTKOPF (127) was doing a routine vehicle patrol of campus when I noticed three individuals standing on the corner of 8th and 20th. A staff member RUTTEN, RICHARD waved me down and explained that he was about to call on their suspicious behavior. I was inquiring about specifically what behaviors they were exhibiting when suddenly one of the males, a younger African American male wearing a black hoodie with graphics on the sleeves and back walked up to the rear passenger window and broke it. I immediately put the maintenance truck in drive. I sped to attempt to intervene when I pulled up next to the vehicle on the grass. The individual jumped into the vehicle and then quickly climbed out of the drivers side rear.

During this time I noticed one of the other males, wearing a black hoodie and gray skinny jeans seem to reach into his front waistband and run towards me. I was uncertain if the male was armed but before I could begin to retreat all three males ran off. During which I allowed distance and observed and gave dispatch descriptions.

Three African American males that appeared younger. One wearing a black coat with a red beanie, one wearing a hoodie

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with graphic designs on the arms and back with red shoes, and one wearing a plain black hoodie with gray skinny jeans.

They fled behind the Fire Station just off of 9th street. I then saw them cross 21st Ave S in an alley between Holiday and an apartment complex. I then later saw them begin crossing the 94 walk bridge back towards campus. As I passed the doubled back and I lost line of sight. Please refer to Direction of Travel in Digital Media.

During this time 120 relayed information to dispatch of the vehicle that was broken into and identified the owner of the break in. We attempted to call, call their sports coach, and finally 120 left them an email. At time of recording this report they have not come forward yet.

During this call MPD was given information of direction of travel and description. As well as last known location.
