

Riverside Construction: Completion

Use caution on campus when crossing streets and driving in the area.

The City of Minneapolis project on Riverside Ave. from 23rd Ave. S. to Cedar Ave will move to completion the week of October 22nd 2012. Friday October 19th, Riverside will be closed for final paving. Riverside will then re-open for traffic. Detours will be removed; parking will return to its previous condition. Please continue to use caution during this transition. Construction personnel will continue to be present as work will continue with sidewalks, boulevards, and street lighting.

Friday October 19th

Pending any inclement weather, Riverside will undergo final paving on Friday October 19th. During this time, Riverside will be closed from 20th Ave S to 22nd Ave S. Expect longer delays in the morning. After completion, Riverside will re-open for traffic along the entirety of the street.

Friday October 19th - Monday October 22nd

Detour signs will be removed. The temporary two –way streets around Murphy Park will return to one- way traffic. The temporary parking restrictions along these streets will be removed. The City of Minneapolis anticipates that the temporary traffic and parking signs/detours will be completely removed by end of the day Monday October 22nd. Please use caution during this transition.

- Slow down. Be aware of construction workers, bicyclists, and pedestrians that may be in unexpected areas due to the construction.
- Pay close attention to Minneapolis parking restrictions and changes throughout campus to avoid tickets/towing.
