

Plan for extra travel time June 1-4 to accommodate construction delays, detours

Use caution driving, crossing streets on campus

Students, faculty and staff traveling to and from campus June 1- 4 should plan extra time for construction delays and detours. The second phase of construction on Riverside Ave., combined with work on westbound I-94, means the community may encounter multiple detours. Known closures and detours impacting travel to and from campus include:

• Traveling from St. Paul, westbound on I-94, from June 1- 4: Visitors to campus who travel from the east (St. Paul) should plan alternate routes because westbound I-94 will be closed between Hwy 280 and Hwy 55/Hiawatha from 9 p.m., Friday, June 1, until 5 a.m., Monday, June 4. This closure means the westbound on/off ramps at Riverside Ave. and Cedar Ave. also will be closed.

Official detours

- **For motorists east of I-35E:** Northbound I-35E to westbound Hwy 36 to southbound I-35W to westbound I-94.
- For motorists west of I-35E: Northbound Hwy 280 to northbound I-35W to westbound I-694 to westbound I-94.
- Visitors to campus should plan alternate routes to campus. On-campus traffic may be higher throughout the construction period. Please use caution when driving and walking in the area, and follow the signs, rules and laws of the road. Pedestrians should cross only at marked crosswalks.

It is impossible to predict how heavy traffic might be, or to offer a specific amount of extra time required to get to campus. In addition, ramp and road closures may change with little or no notice. Construction Season Safety Tips & Reminders:

- Only cross the streets at intersections and cross walks.
- Look both ways before crossing the street. Vehicles unfamiliar to campus may be traveling through.
- Be aware of vehicles accidentally traveling the wrong direction on one-way streets.
- Slow down. Be aware of construction workers, bicyclists, and pedestrians that may be in unexpected areas due to the construction.
- Pay close attention to Minneapolis parking restrictions and changes throughout campus to avoid tickets/towing.
 Parking is available for Augsburg Faculty, Staff, Students, and Visitors in any of the Augsburg parking lots.
 Permits are still required in any reserved, metered, handicap, or similar spaces on campus.
