On the evening of April 5th 2011, a residential student of Anderson Hall notified Public Safety that a television was missing from their residence. The student stated that their door had been left locked but was unlocked and ajar when they returned. There were no signs of forced entry. The burglary happened sometime between the evening of April 1 and April 5 2011. There are currently no suspects in this crime.

You Can Help Prevent Crime at Augsburg!

- Lock valuables, including cash, credit cards, and electronics in a drawer. Thieves frequently target rooms where valuables are plainly visible through windows.
- Lock all doors to your residence even if you or your roommates are home.
- Always lock your office and/or apartment whenever you leave, even if you will only be gone briefly. Most home burglaries take only 3 to 5 minutes.
- Make sure strangers are not walking in behind you (tailgating) when you enter your residence hall.
- Be aware of strangers who may be looking for valuables to return and steal later. Immediately report suspicious activity to Augsburg DPS.
- Keep your car keys on your person at all times. If a crook can take your keys, they can take your car.
