Sizing the Opportunity: The Quality and Extent of Online Education in the United States, 2002-2003

- Funded by the Sloan Foundation, this report asked:
 - Will students embrace online education? YES
 - Will institutions embrace online education? YES
 - Will faculty embrace online education? UNSURE
 - Will the quality match that of face to face instruction? YES

Increasing Enrollment

 Over 1.6 million students took at least one course online in 2002.

- 11% of all students in higher education took courses online.
- 2003-2004 is expected to show a 20% increase in online student enrollment.

Institutional Embracement

- Will institutions of higher education embrace online education?
 - 81% of all institutions of higher education offer at least one fully or blended course.
 - Complete online degrees are offered by 34% of the institutions.
 - 67% of respondents believe online education is a critical long-term strategy.



Faculty Acceptance

 60% of academic leaders believe their faculty accept and value online education...

 Which means that nearly 40% do not...



Quality Concerns

 Nearly 60% of academic leaders believe today's online courses are equal to or superior to their face to face counterpart.
