

<u>Where Can You Find It?</u>: You can review your student account, check on your financial aid status or submit required documents, and schedule an appointment all at https://www.augsburg.edu/studentfinancial/

Is Your Bill Paid? Are You Sure?: Go to the Student Financial Services website and click on 'Review Your Student Account' to make sure your bill is paid, as finance charges are now accruing on any past due balance; also, be sure to review the online statement that is emailed to your Augsburg email address each month.

How Do You Make Payments?: Payments can be made online by going to http://www.augsburg.edu/studentfinancial/payments/. PLUS Loan (Parent Loan for Undergraduate Students) and other private loans can still be applied for at

Are You Missing Financial Aid Documents? All financial aid applications for the current academic year should be completed by April 15th. Failure to meet this deadline will likely result in a loss of financial aid. Contact our office if you have not yet completed your financial aid application or if you have concerns about meeting this deadline. You can see what documents are missing on our website by clicking on "Review Your Financial Aid".

Are You Filing 2019 Taxes?: Any student who had qualifying education expenses during 2019 will soon be notified that their 1098-T is available for their 2019 tax preparation. You can view the form by logging on to AugNet Records and Registration and clicking on 'Make Payment/Account Activity'. The 1098-T tax form can be found on the bottom right-hand side of this page.

Spring Tuition Charges:

The spring 2020 billing statements were electronically sent to all registered students on January 7th with a due date of February 1st; any remaining balance after that date is subject to finance charges. You will have an email sent to your Augsburg email account during the first week of each month reminding you to view your online monthly bill; all students are encouraged to give parents/guardians access to view these statements by logging into Inside Augsburg/Records and Registration/Information Release.

Payment Plans: Students can still enroll in the Online Payment Plan at

http://www.augsburg.edu/studen tfinancial/payment-plans-anddiscounts. However, you must enroll by January 27th to have your remaining balance divided into four payments.

Please note that we will be unable to speak with any parent/guardian that has not been authorized by the student.

Private Loans Still Available:

PLUS (Parent Loan for Undergraduate Students) and other private loans can still be applied for at https://www.augsburg.edu/studentfinancial/loans/undergraduate-day-2/. Please note that all PLUS or private loan applications can take up to two weeks to process/be received by Augsburg.

Credit Refunds: Credit refunds will be issued by February 14th.

January 27 – Last day to add or drop a full term course

January 31 – Last day to withdraw from all courses and receive 50% refund

Log into Inside Augsburg /Records and Registration /Information Release/Add An Authorization/Save Authorization/ if you want to authorize us to speak to a third party or parent on your behalf. If you want a parent or guardian to receive your monthly statements, you will also need to click on the CashNet tab.
