

## **Family Medicine Learning Outcomes**

FM 1: Demonstrate an understanding of scientific concepts and the knowledge necessary for: history taking, physical exam, diagnostic studies, differential diagnosis, clinical intervention and therapeutics, and preventive health maintenance of medical conditions seen in the outpatient family medicine setting.

FM 2: Communicate effectively with patients and other professionals in the outpatient family medicine setting.

FM 3: Perform a history & physical exam, interpret diagnostic studies, develop a management plan, provide patient education, document patient encounter and deliver an oral presentation of common conditions in the outpatient family medicine setting.

FM 4: Demonstrate proficiency in taking a history for an elderly patient presenting with a common chronic family medicine complaint.

FM 5: Demonstrate the ability to think critically and problem solve to make informed decisions about diagnostic and therapeutic interventions using patient information, scientific evidence and clinical judgment.

FM 6: Perform a physical exam on an infant, using techniques appropriate for this age group and communicate the findings to the parents considering the families individual background.

FM 7: Perform and document a preventive healthcare visit for an adult patient including recommendations for population health-based screenings using the USPSTF EPSS tool in the outpatient setting.

FM 8: Professionally communicate a focused oral case presentation of an adolescent patient with a common acute family medicine complaint to a colleague.

FM 9: Demonstrate respect, compassion and empathy to patients and colleagues, displaying sensitivity to one's individual background.

FM 10: Using medical knowledge, demonstrate the ability to think critically and problem solve to develop a therapeutic intervention for a child with a common acute family medicine complaint in the outpatient setting.

FM 11: Develop a differential diagnosis for an adult patient presenting with a common acute family medicine complaint.
