### **Get Ready initiative visits Ever Cat Fuels, LLC**

Last Thursday, Jan. 13, a team of Augsburg faculty, staff, and students from both Minneapolis and Rochester traveled to Isanti, Minn. to visit the Ever Cat Fuels plant as part of the Get Ready initiative to prepare the campus community for the Center for Science, Business, and Religion. The team heard from Clayton McNeff '91, cofounder of Ever Cat and co-chair of the CSBR campaign, about the history of the Ever Cat facility, the company's plans and goals, and the role the CSBR will play in developing future scientists and leaders. After the time at Ever Cat, the participants had a discussion about their academic aspirations for science, business, and religion at Augsburg and about how those aspirations can be greatly aided by the new building.
