### **MAJOR ACHIEVEMENTS AND HAPPENINGS**

Augsburg College has been recognized by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) as the **2010-11 top green power purchaser in the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference** (MIAC). Augsburg College purchased more than 13 million kilowatt-hours (kWh) of green power, representing 100 percent of the school's annual electricity usage on the Minneapolis campus. This is more than half of the total MIAC collective green power purchase and is equivalent to avoiding the carbon dioxide (CO<sub>2</sub>) emissions from the electricity use of more than 1,000 average American homes or nearly 2,000 cars annually.

**More students than ever exhibited their research posters** at the Zyzzogeton poster session last Wednesday, sponsored by the McNair, URGO, and LSAMP (North Star STEM Alliance) programs. The sixth annual Zyzzogeton festival on Wednesday and Thursday celebrated the creativity and scholarship of undergraduate students.

Augsburg Board of Regents chair **Mike Good '71** and athletic director **Jeff Swenson '79** were inducted on Friday evening into the National Wrestling Hall of Fame, Minnesota Chapter. Mike was recognized as the year's Outstanding American, honoring wrestlers who have used the disciplines of the sport to launch notable careers. Jeff was honored for Lifetime Service in his successful career, which includes an individual national championship, 30 seasons as a coach winning a record 10 national team championships, and current work as athletic director.
