Regents elect CEO of Lutheran Social Service as chair: Jodi Harpstead, CEO of Lutheran Social Service of Minnesota, was elected chair of the Board of Regents earlier this summer. As chair of the governing board of the College, Harpstead will play a key leadership role in Augsburg's planning and fundraising initiatives. She will guide the Board's oversight of the College's strategic priorities, including:

- Helping define the plan to build a signature academic building, the Center for Science, Business and Religion;
- Ensuring the quality and relevance of the academic offerings; and
- Monitoring the development of a long-range enrollment plan for the college.
