Nobel Peace Prize Forum. Registration is open for the 25th annual Nobel Peace Prize Forum, cohosted by Augsburg in partnership with a range of other organizations. This year's keynote speakers include:

- 2011 Peace Laureate Tawakkol Karman, a Yemeni journalist and the first Arab woman to win the prize.
- Muhammad Yunus, 2006 Peace Laureate, an economist and a leading proponent of the microcredit movement.
- Dr. Paul Farmer, cofounder of Partners in Health, and a leading thinker on health and human rights. He also serves as chair of Harvard Medical School's Department of Global Health and Social Medicine.
