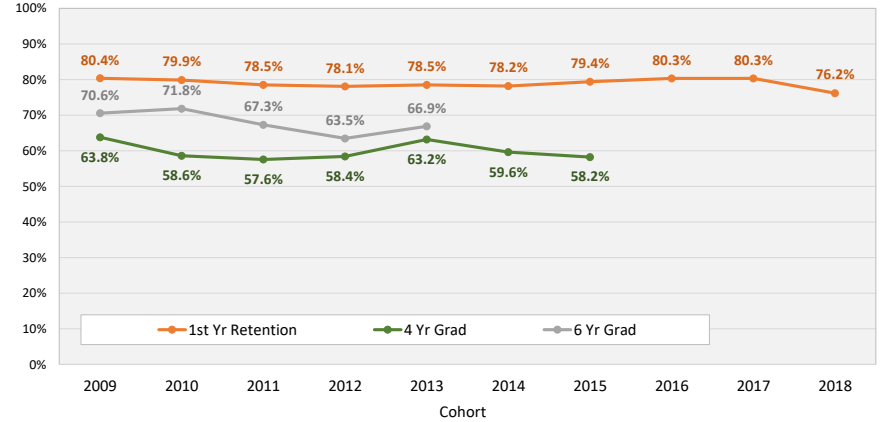

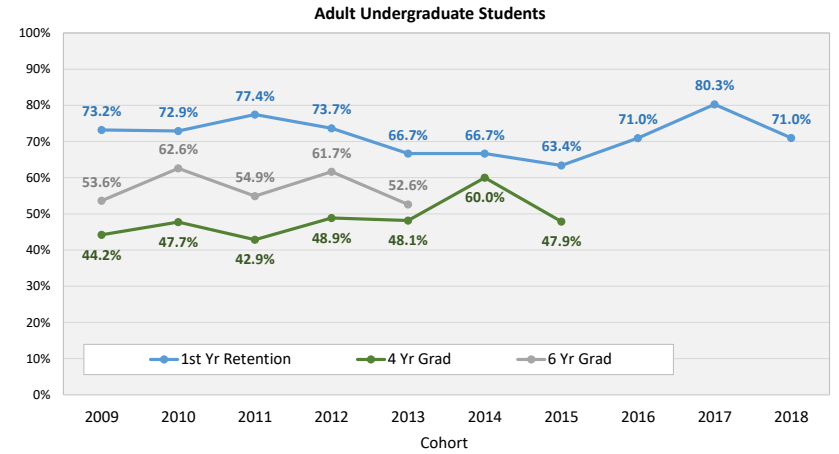

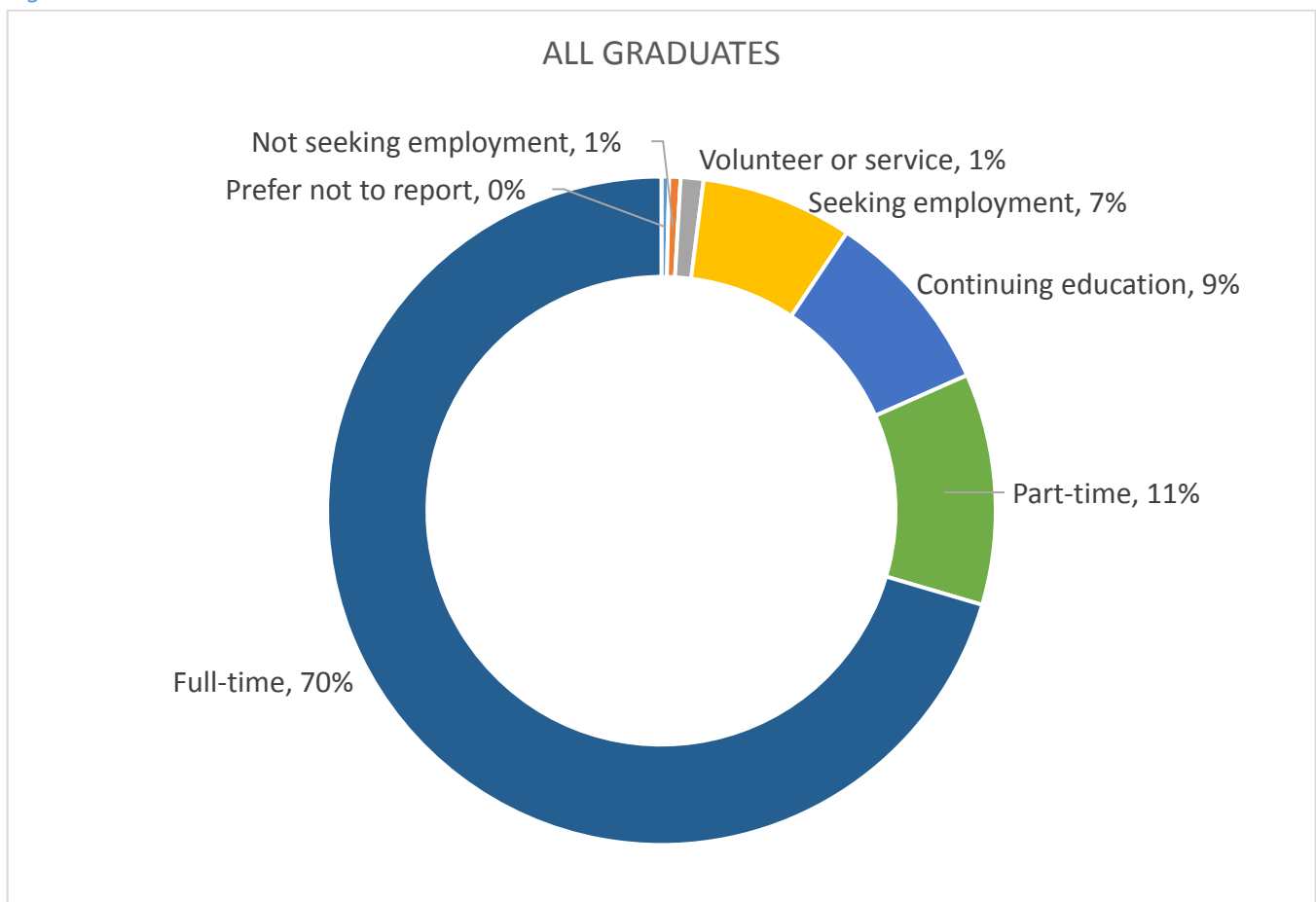

PRIMARY ACTIVITY

Of the graduates for whom data was collected (Figure 1), 70% were employed full-time, 11% were employed part-time, and 9% were continuing their education full time. The percentage of graduates that indicated full-time employment decreased from 78% in 2016, while part-time employment increased from 7% in 2016 to 11% in 2017. There was also an increase in continuing education (7% in 2016, 9% in 2017). Lastly, the percentage of respondents “still seeking” employment increased (5% in 2016, 7% in 2017). In 2017, more graduates were working part time or continuing their education than in the previous year.

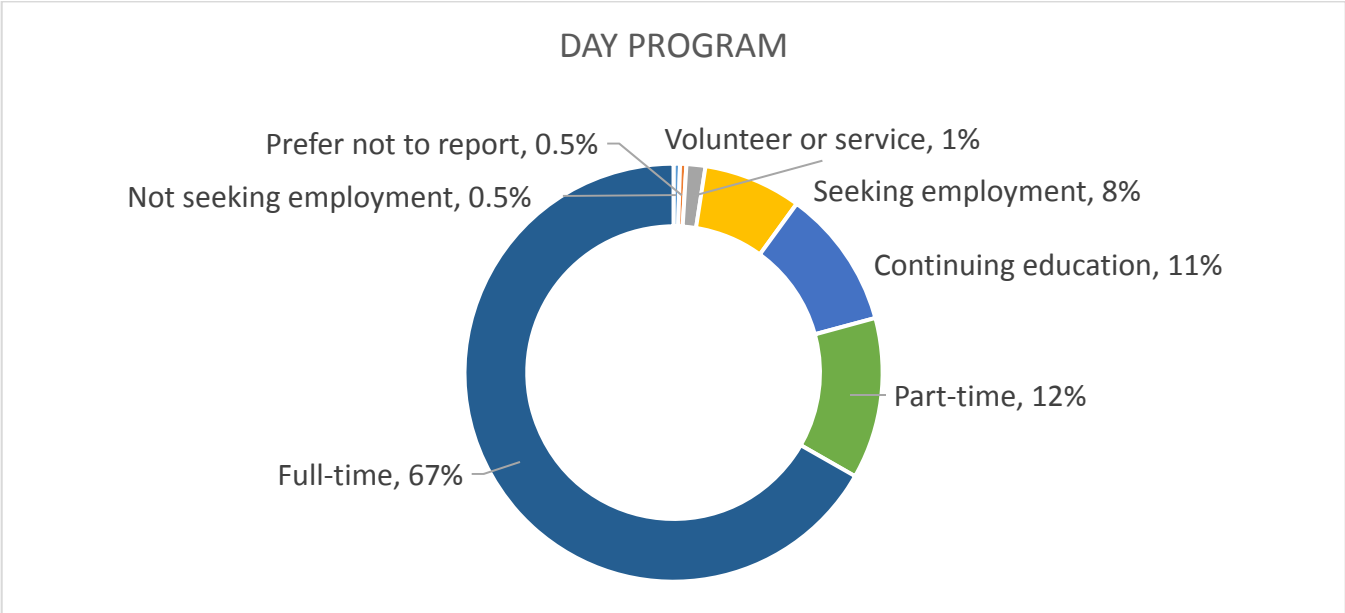
More adult learners (82%) indicated they were employed full-time than traditional day respondents (67%); the number of day graduates employed full time saw a decrease from the previous year (73% in 2016). Traditional day respondents were pursuing a wider variety of activities than adult learners and more day graduates are continuing education full-time than adult learners (11% and 4% respectively).

For traditional day graduates (Figure 2), full-time employment (67%), part-time employment (12%), and continuing education (11%) were the most common activities following graduation.
