## Entry Level Skills

	Description	Course Meeting Requirement
<b>Writing Skill</b>	ENG 111 (or equivalent trans. course) is required for graduation. The Writing assessment is required if you have not completed a college-level composition course.	
<b>Math Skill</b>	If you have taken a college-level math course in the past five years, your math placement group (MPG) is listed here. If not, you must take Augsburg's Math placement test. A score placing you in MPG 3 is required for graduation.	
<b>Augsburg Seminar</b>	Augsburg Seminar (freshman experience) is required for all day program students entering with fewer than 7 course credits.	
<b>Critical Thinking</b>	Entry level skills in critical thinking will be assessed. The critical thinking exam is waived for students with advanced transfer status. All Nursing majors will complete the critical thinking exam as part of the Nursing major.
