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Theatre Practicum Units: Theatre majors are required to participate in departmental productions. Practicum units are required in the areas of Acting & Performance, Production, and Artistic/Production Management. Each unit requires at least 30 hours of assessed participation. At least 1 practicum unit must be in costuming and 1 in lighting.

Theatre Arts Practicum Units: Student must register for practicum units in the term in which the units are completed.

Performance: 1-5 practicum units; register for THP 111/121/131/141/151 (1 practicum unit).

QR is satisfied by completing one (1) Quantitative Foundational course (QF) and one (1) Quantitative Application course (QA), or one (1) combined QFA course.
