Anoka-Ramsey Community College Approved courses for Business Department

For students planning to transfer to Augsburg University and pursue a major in the Business department, the following major equivalencies are provided. All business majors at Augsburg are available as a Bachelor of Arts degree. Majors offered include: <u>Accounting</u>, <u>Combined Business and Economics</u>, <u>Finance</u>, <u>International Business</u>, <u>Marketing</u>, <u>Management</u>, <u>Management</u> <u>Information Systems</u> and <u>Music Business</u>. The following courses are part of the Business core, must be taken within the last 10 years with a C- or better to be accepted in transfer. If transferring as a junior, it is recommended to complete at least five of these courses prior to transfer.
