

## Anoka-Ramsey Community College Approved courses for Social Work

For students planning to transfer to Augsburg University and major in Social Work, the following departmental equivalencies are provided. This guide is intended as a supplement to Augsburg's general transfer guide available online at <a href="http://web.augsburg.edu/registrar/transfer/guides/arcc.pdf">http://web.augsburg.edu/registrar/transfer/guides/arcc.pdf</a>.

The Social Work major at Augsburg is available as a <u>Bachelor of Science degree</u>. Students who transfer to Augsburg as a junior can begin the BSW program in the fall term. A minimum of four courses listed below must be completed prior to transfer for a fall start in the program.

The table below lists the Anoka-Ramsey courses that have approved equivalencies at Augsburg University.

BIOL 1104 The Human Body- Structure & Function*	Meets Human Biology BSW requirement

MATH 1114 Introduction to Statistics	MAT 163 Introductory Statistics
Choose one of the following: ECON 2205 Principles of Macroeconomics POLS 1111 American Politics & Government	ECO 112 Principles of Macroeconomics  POL 121 American Government and Politics

\*BIOL 1104 has the required content for the BSW program. Since there is no lab it does not equal BIO121.

- Students must apply and be admitted to Augsburg by August 1 to start the BSW program in the fall term.
- A minimum of four prerequisite courses must be completed prior to transfer at the junior level.
