

Century College Approved courses for Physics majors

For students planning to transfer to Augsburg University and major in Physics, the following departmental equivalencies are provided. This guide is intended as a supplement to Augsburg's general transfer guide available online at http://web.augsburg.edu/registrar/transfer/guides/century.pdf.

The Physics major at Augsburg is available as a <u>Bachelor of Arts</u> or a <u>Bachelor of Science</u>. A major in <u>Bio-Physics</u> and a Pre-engineering track are also available. Courses are available in the traditional undergraduate program.
