

Normandale Community College Approved Courses for Biology Majors

The following transfer equivalencies have been pre-approved for students planning to transfer to Augsburg University and major in Biology. This guide is intended as a supplement to Augsburg's general transfer guide available online at http://web.augsburg.edu/registrar/transfer/guides/normandale.pdf.

The Biology major at Augsburg is available as <u>Bachelor of Science</u> (BS). These courses can also apply to the <u>Biopsychology</u> <u>B.S.</u> (BPSY) and <u>Biochemistry</u> B.S. (BCHM) and the 5-12 Biology teaching license. Courses must be completed with a C- or better and be less than 10 years old to transfer to the major.
