

**MINNESOTA STATE COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES
ARTICULATION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
NORTH HENNEPIN COMMUNITY COLLEGE
AND
AUGSBURG COLLEGE**

This Agreement is entered into between North Hennepin Community College (herein North Hennepin) and Augsburg College (herein Augsburg).

This Agreement and any amendments and supplements, shall be interpreted pursuant to the laws of the State of Minnesota.

North Hennepin has established an Associate of Science (A.S.) degree in Physical Education and Augsburg has established a Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) degree in Physical Education, and will facilitate credit transfer and provide a smooth transition from one related program to another. Augsburg also offers a Bachelor of Science (B.S.) degree in Physical Education for students wishing to pursue a teaching license in Minnesota. Requirements for licensure are established by the Minnesota Board to Teaching, are subject to change, and are not included in this agreement.

The Board of Trustees of the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities is authorized by Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 136F to enter into Agreements and has delegated this authority to colleges and universities.

It is mutually agreed upon:

Admission and Graduation Requirements

- A. Augsburg admission requirements apply to both direct entry students and to students who transfer under this agreement.
- B. A cumulative GPA of 2.5 or better is recommended for transfer student admission at Augsburg.
- C. The Physical Education major at Augsburg does not have a separate admission process.
- D. Students accepted into Augsburg must fulfill all graduation requirements to earn the B.A. or B.S. degree.

Transfer of Credits

- A. Augsburg operates on a course credit system where each course is offered for 1.0 credit, which equates to 4 semester hours. Some courses are offered for 0.25 credits or 0.5 credits which equate to 1 or 2 semester hours respectively.
- B. Augsburg will accept up to 64 semester credits from 2-year institutions to apply toward degree requirement at Augsburg.
- C. A minimum of 32 course credits (128 semester hours) is required a bachelor's degree at Augsburg.
- D. Courses will transfer as described in the Program Articulation Table included in the Articulation Agreement.
- E. Remedial/developmental and technical courses do not transfer to Augsburg.
- F. A grade of C or better is required to transfer any course to Augsburg.
- G. Based on the prescribed courses of study, it is likely that students who complete the A.S. degree in Physical education at North Hennepin will reach *Advanced Transfer* status, that is having 13 or more transferable credits (52 semester hours) upon entering Augsburg.

- H. North Hennepin students who achieve *Advanced Transfer* status will receive the following waivers/substitutions in regard to completing the general education requirements (Core Curriculum) at Augsburg:
 - a. Waiver of the Entry Level Critical Thinking Requirement
 - b. Placement into REL 300 instead of taking REL100/200
- I. This agreement implies no guarantee of Advanced Transfer status to North Hennepin students. Transfer standing will be determined by the Registrar's Office at Augsburg in the evaluation of final official transcripts.

Terms of Agreement

- A. The Chief Academic Officers or designees of the parties to this agreement will implement the terms of this agreement, including identifying and incorporating any changes into subsequent agreements, assuring compliance with system policy, procedure and guidelines, and conducting a periodic review of this agreement.
- B. Program curriculum and requirements listed in the Program Articulation Table may change.
- C. This Articulation Agreement is effective on 12/01/2010 and shall remain in effect until 12/01/2015 unless terminated or amended by either party with 90 days prior written notice.
- D. This Articulation Agreement will be reviewed by both parties beginning on or after 06/01/2015.
