

Approved Courses from Rochester Community & Technical College Associate of Science Degree in Nursing

The table below lists the courses from the RCTC nursing program and the corresponding Augsburg Core Curriculum requirements. The courses noted below have been reviewed and approved for substitution.

Prescribed Courses in the Rochester Community & Technical College Nursing Program	Augsburg College Core Curriculum Requirements
ENGL 1117 Reading and Writing Critically I	ENL 111 Effective Writing
CHEM 1117 General, Organic, and Biological Chemistry	NSM Fulfills one of two requirements in Natural Science & Mathematics; may fulfill the lab science portion of this requirement
BIOL 1217 Anatomy and Physiology I	NSM Fulfills one of two requirements in Natural
-OR- BIOL 1218 Anatomy and Physiology II	Science & Mathematics; may fulfill the lab science portion of this requirement
PSYC 2618 General Psychology	SBSFulfills one of two requirements in Social and Behavioral Science; equivalent to PSY 105
SOC 1614 Introduction to Sociology	SBSFulfills one of two requirements in Social and Behavioral Science; equivalent to SOC 121
PHIL 1125 Ethics	HUMFulfills one of two requirements in Humanities; equivalent to PHI 120

Advising Information:

It is recommended that most liberal arts courses be taken before starting the nursing major at Augsburg. Students interested in taking additional liberal arts courses at RCTC should consult Augsburg's *Transfer Guide*.

Augsburg strongly encourages students to complete RCTC coursework that fulfills these requirements:

- Entry-level Mathematics Skill requirement (refer to Transfer Guide for approved courses)
- At least one Lifetime Fitness requirement (refer to Transfer Guide for approved courses)
- At least one Fine Arts requirement (refer to Transfer Guide for approved courses)

Students who are interested in pursuing an advanced degree in nursing (Master of Arts in Nursing) also should consider taking a course in descriptive/inferential statistics such as MATH 2208 at RCTC.

Keep in mind:

- Students may transfer up to 64 semester credits (16 course credits) of liberal arts coursework from two-year institutions.
- Any course with a grade below C will not be accepted in transfer.
- No individual nursing courses at Rochester Community and Technical College can substitute for courses in the nursing major at Augsburg.
- Upon completion of the associate degree in nursing, students are granted 6 course credits to encompass previous nursing coursework. These credits apply directly toward baccalaureate degree requirements.
