MINNESOTA STATE COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES* ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN

RIVERLAND COMMUNITY COLLEGE AND AUGSBURG COLLEGE (non-MnSCU)

*The Board of Trustees of the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities is authorized by Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 136F to enter into Agreements and has delegated this authority to colleges and universities.

This Agreement is entered into between **Riverland Community College** (hereinafter sending institution), and **Augsburg College** (hereinafter receiving institution). This Agreement and any amendments and supplements, shall be interpreted pursuant to the laws of the State of Minnesota.

The sending institution has established an **Associate in Science degree in nursing** (hereinafter sending program), and the receiving institution has established a **Bachelor of Science degree in nursing** (hereinafter receiving program), and will facilitate credit transfer and provide a smooth transition from one related program to another. It is mutually agreed:

Admission and Graduation Requirements

- A. Students must fulfill the graduation requirements at both institutions.
- B. Students must complete the entire sending program and meet the receiving institution's admission requirements for the agreement to apply.
- C. The receiving program is for degree completion only (A.S. to B.S.) therefore all nursing students enter as transfer students.
- D. A cumulative GPA of 2.5 or better in all previous post-secondary coursework is recommended for transfer student admission at Augsburg.
- E. In addition to meeting admission requirements at the receiving institution, admission to the receiving program requires the following:
 - a. Completion of an Associate of Science degree in nursing with a 2.5 or higher GPA
 - b. Unencumbered RN licensure must be a registered nurse who is licensed and currently registered to practice in Minnesota prior to beginning the nursing major
 - c. Evidence of practice as a registered nurse
 - d. Personal malpractice insurance
 - e. Required immunizations for health care providers
 - f. Evidence of HIPAA training
 - g. Federal criminal background check

Transfer of Credits

- A. Courses will transfer as described in the attached Program Articulation Table.
- B. A grade of C or better is required to transfer any course to Augsburg.
- C. Remedial/developmental and technical courses do not transfer to Augsburg.
- D. Individual nursing courses from the sending institution are not transferable to the receiving institution. Instead a block of 24 semester hours is granted to encompass previous nursing coursework.
- E. Based on the prescribed courses, the sending program will result in 57 semester hours transferring to the receiving program. A total of 71 semester hours remain to complete the receiving program.

Note: Augsburg operates on a course credit system where each course is offered for 1.0 credit, which equates to 4 semester hours. Augsburg will accept up to 64 semester hours (16 course credits) of liberal arts courses from two-year sending institutions to apply toward degree requirement. For the purpose of this agreement all credits are shown in semester hours.

Implementation and Review

- A. The Chief Academic Officers or designees of the parties to this agreement will implement the terms of this agreement, including identifying and incorporating any changes into subsequent agreements, assuring compliance with system policy, procedure and guidelines, and conducting a periodic review of this agreement.
- B. This Articulation Agreement is effective on 06/01/2012 and shall remain in effect until the end date of 06/01/2017 or for five years, whichever occurs first, unless terminated or amended by either party with 90 days prior written notice.
- C. The college and university shall work with students to resolve the transfer of courses should changes to either program occur while the agreement is in effect.
- D. This Articulation Agreement will be reviewed by both parties beginning 12/01/2016 (within six months of the end date).
