

## Riverland Community College Approved courses for Social Work

For students planning to transfer to Augsburg University and major in Social Work, the following departmental equivalencies are provided. The Social Work major at Augsburg is available as a <u>Bachelor of Science degree</u>. Students who transfer to Augsburg as a junior can begin the BSW program in the fall term. A minimum of four courses listed below must be completed prior to transfer for a fall start in the program, in addition to the HSER courses listed.

The table below lists the Riverland Community College courses that have approved equivalencies at Augsburg University.

- Students must apply and be admitted to Augsburg by August 1 to start the BSW program in the fall term.
- A minimum of four prerequisite courses must be completed prior to transfer at the junior level.
