Approved courses for Business Department

For students planning to transfer to Augsburg University and pursue a major in the Business department, the following major equivalencies are provided. This guide is intended as a supplement to Augsburg's general transfer guide available online at <http://web.augsburg.edu/registrar/transfer/guides/stpaul.pdf>.

All business majors at Augsburg are available as a Bachelor of Arts degree. Majors offered include: [Accounting](#), [Combined Business and Economics](#), [Finance](#), [International Business](#), [Marketing](#), [Management](#), [Management Information Systems](#) and [Music Business](#). The following courses are part of the Business core, must be taken within the last 10 years with a C- or better to be accepted in transfer. If transferring as a junior, it is recommended to complete at least five of these courses prior to transfer.
