Students may also choose to add individual courses for personal interest.

Advising Notes:

- ENGL 2203, 2204, 2207, 2208, and 2209 will transfer in as lower division literature electives equivalent to ENL 280 Genres.
- ENGL 2210 will transfer in as a lower division literature elective, ENL 270 Themes.
- ENGL 2230 American Literature to 1865 and ENGL 2235 American Literature Since 1865 will transfer in together as an upper-division major elective in literature, ENL 352 American Literature from 1900-1945.
- ENGL 2220 British Literature to 1800 and ENGL 2225 British Literature Since 1800 will transfer in together as an upper-division major elective in literature, ENL 336 Age of Victoria.
