

General Education Indirect Equivalencies

Step-by-Step Instructions

1. Create a log-in for Transferology and/or log in to Transferology (transferology.com).
2. Click on “Find a Replacement Course” in the upper right to highlight the tab.

3. Click on the “Requirement Categories” tab.

4. Click on the large plus sign to the right of all general education requirement(s) that are highlighted in **green**** below. Then click on the large plus sign in front of all other general education Requirement Categories that you are interested in satisfying through transfer work.
Only the rows highlighted below are applicable to catalog years 2025 and forward, so only choose them.

If your catalog year is prior to Fall 2025, you either need to 1) switch to the similar [“prior to 2025 catalog year” instructions](#) or 2) choose from the rows below that are NOT highlighted and realize that some parts of the instructions will refer to the new general education requirements rather than to the Liberal Arts Foundation categories.

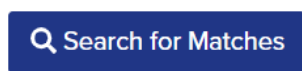

5. Notice that your selected general education category (or categories) appear in the upper right.

6. Click on “Search for Matches.”

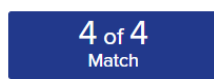


7. In the “Filter by school or city name” field, type the name of the school at which you would like to take one or more courses to satisfy Augsburg general education requirements.

8. Click on the “Search” button to the right.



9. Identify your transfer institution of choice in the results list. Click on the “# of # Match” button to its left. The numbers in the # positions will vary.



10. Notice that there are tab(s) directly below the name of the transfer institution. Click on the “# Requirement Category Matches” tab. Notice that there is a hyperlink for some or all of the general education Requirement Categories that you selected earlier:

11. One hyperlink at a time, perform the following steps:
 - a. Click on the hyperlink of the Requirement Category.
 - b. Click on the drop-down arrow and choose “All” at the top of the list.

- d. Click on the “Print” button in the upper right and select “Print Current Tab.” If you do not have a printer, select the destination of “Save as PDF” and save the document to your desktop for future reference.



***Due to technical limitations with Transferology, not all indirect equivalents will appear on the report, unfortunately. Many of Augsburg’s general education courses can apply to two Requirement Categories, but the designers of Transferology only programmed Transferology to allow courses to apply to one Requirement Category, not two. For those transfer courses that can apply to two Requirement Categories, the Registrar’s Office Transfer/Graduation Team has set up Transferology to have the course apply to a theme (Local & Global Perspectives; Equity, Power & Social Justice; Sustainability & Wellness).

****We advise looking at your theme print-outs for additional likely courses.** For example, if you are interested in taking a history course to satisfy Humanities (*notice that there are history courses listed on the Humanities print-out*), look at the following theme print-outs to see if they include history courses, too: Local & Global Perspectives; Equity, Power & Social Justice; Sustainability & Wellness. Most likely a history course included on one of the theme’s print-outs will also satisfy Humanities, even though the course is not included on the Humanities print-out. 12. Repeat the steps under #11 for each of the Requirement Category hyperlinks.
13. **If** there is a tab called “# Course Match” (*like pictured below*) under the institution’s name, click on the tab, look at the right column to see which courses indirectly satisfy Augsburg’s Effective Writing II, and click on the “Print” button in the upper right as you did for step 11d.
