Submission Instructions

Submissions for presentation include individual papers, poster presentations, and organized workshops. This conference encourages presentations as they relate to social work in the micro, macro, or policy level in any part of the world. Abstracts should be submitted in a structure that includes the following:

- Title (25 words or less)
- Presenters and presenter information (100 words or less)
- An abstract of 500 words or less that includes:
 - Background
 - Purpose
 - Research or program design
 - Results and or practice implications
 - Overall contribution to social work
