Internships 2015

Metropolitan Council, established in 1967 by the Minnesota Legislature, is the regional planning agency serving the Twin Cities seven-county metropolitan area and providing essential services to the region. The Council, has over 4200 employees and 35+ facilities region-wide, works with local communities to:

- Operate the region's largest bus system
- Collect and treat wastewater
- Engage communities and the public in planning for future growth
- Provide forecasts of the region's population and household growth
- Provide affordable housing opportunities for low- and moderate-income individuals and families
- Provide planning, acquisitions and funding for a regional system of parks and trails
- Provide a framework for decisions and implementation for regional systems including aviation, transportation, parks and open space, water quality, and water management.

These assignments provide students with a chance to learn about the Council, apply their education to real-life work opportunities and prepare themselves for future jobs. The jobs pay \$15.50 based on job duties and required entry profile. Most positions will start mid-May or earlier depending on student availability and the department's needs. Positions are full or part time lasting through the summer (10-12 weeks). Some positions continue part time during the school year.
