

TRiO/Student Support Services (SSS) Application

Established in 2001, Augsburg TRiO/Student Support Services (SSS) is funded by the U.S. Department of Education and Augsburg College. The Minnesota Department of Education Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) provides additional funding for Summer Bridge. Augsburg TRiO/SSS annually provides individual and group services to 160 students so that they develop the skills and motivation necessary to achieve a bachelor's degree.

TRiO/SSS serves all program participants regardless of race, color, creed, religion, national or ethnic origin, gender, sexual orientation, disability, marital status, or age.

TRiO/SSS is not a scholarship program! However, a limited number of active participants may qualify and receive a program-based scholarship contingent on annual funding.

Students participate in TRiO/SSS throughout their enrollment at Augsburg College. **It is expected that program participants meet with their TRiO/SSS advisor or engage in other activities at least once per month.**

Program Eligibility

Augsburg TRiO/SSS participants must be U. S. citizens or permanent residents or refugees pursuing their first bachelor's degree. Participants must be **incoming or currently enrolled Augsburg College students**. Program participants must **demonstrate academic need for services and meet at least one of the following criteria:**

- Low-income student: a student whose family meets federal income eligibility guidelines as verified by Augsburg College (please see Income Eligibility Guidelines Chart at:
- First generation college student: a student where neither (custodial) parent has received a bachelor's degree or a student who did not regularly live with or receive support from a (custodial) parent
- College student with document disabilities: as defined in the American with Disabilities Act (ADA) and verified by either the Augsburg Center for Learning and Adaptive Services (CLASS) office or the Augsburg ACCESS Center

Selection Process

When there is limited space in the TRiO/SSS program, priority will be given to:

- Students who participate in our Summer Bridge program
- Students who are both income-eligible *and* first generation college students
- Students who are both income-eligible *and* have disabilities that require educational accommodation
- Alumni of other TRiO programs: Upward Bound, (Educational) Talent Search, Educational Opportunity Center, or other Student Support Services programs
- Students who are motivated to take full advantage of services offered through the TRiO/SSS program

2. What skills have you learned to overcome barriers in college? Who taught you these skills or how did you learn these skills?
3. What three goals do you have for yourself as an Augsburg student and as a TRiO/SSS participant?
4. Address the following scenario: there are two equally qualified candidates applying for one remaining spot in the Augsburg TRiO/SSS program. Why are you the best candidate for this last spot?
5. Is there anything else that should be taken into consideration in evaluating your application to TRiO/SSS?
