Established in 2001, Augsburg TRIO/Student Support Services (SSS) is funded by the U.S. Department of Education and Augsburg University. Augsburg TRIO/SSS annually provides individual and group services to 160 students so that they develop the skills and motivation necessary to achieve a bachelor's degree.

TRIO/SSS serves all program participants regardless of race, color, creed, religion, national or ethnic origin, gender, sexual orientation, disability, marital status, or age.

TRIO/SSS is not a scholarship program! However, a limited number of active participants may qualify for and receive a program scholarship contingent on annual funding.

Students participate in TRIO/SSS throughout their enrollment at Augsburg University. It is expected that program participants meet with their TRIO/SSS advisor or engage in other activities at least once per month.

Program Eligibility

Augsburg TRIO/SSS participants must be U. S. citizens or permanent residents or refugees pursuing their first bachelor's degree. Participants must be incoming or currently enrolled Augsburg University students. Program participants must demonstrate academic need for services and meet at least one of the following criteria:

- Low-income student: a student whose family meets federal income eligibility guidelines as verified by Augsburg University and program director (see Income Eligibility Guidelines Chart at: https://www2.ed.gov/about/offices/list/ope/trio/incomelevels.html)
- First generation college student: a student where neither (custodial) parent has received a bachelor's degree or a student who did not regularly live with or receive support from a (custodial) parent
- College student with document disabilities: as defined in the American with Disabilities Act (ADA) and verified by the Augsburg Center for Learning and Accessible Student Services (CLASS)/Disability Resources office

Selection Process

When there is limited space in the TRIO/SSS program, priority will be given to:

- Students who participate in the Summer Bridge program
- Students who are both income-eligible and first generation college students
- > Students who are both income-eligible and have disabilities that require educational accommodation
- Alumni of other TRIO programs: Upward Bound, (Educational) Talent Search, Educational Opportunity Center, or other Student Support Services programs
- > Students who are motivated to take full advantage of services offered through the TRIO/SSS program

Essay Questions

Although your responses will not be judged on structure, be conscious of content, presentation, and take time to formulate well-written responses, as they are a vital part of the selection process and will help us determine whether you are a good candidate for the TRIO/SSS program.

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Answers must be typed in 12-point standard font and double-spaced.

1. TRIO/SSS works with students to address academic, social/personal, and financial concerns as they progress toward graduation. What challenges have you experienced in these areas that presented a barrier to your academic success up to now? How did you address those barriers and how will you address them during college?

2. In addition to graduating from the University, what other goals do you have for yourself as an Augsburg student and as a TRIO/SSS participant and why? How do you anticipate TRIO/SSS will help you achieve those goals?

3. What are your career goals after Augsburg graduation and why? Discuss your 2 year, 5 year, and 10 year post-graduation plans as you pursue these career goals.

4. Describe a belief about which you feel very strongly. Describe the reasons or experiences that led you to this point of view and how you approach someone who does not share your view.

5. TRIO/SSS selection tends to be very competitive among many deserving first generation, low income candidates. If you were applying for the one remaining spot in the TRIO/SSS program why should we choose you? Is there anything else that should be taken into consideration in evaluating your application?



Program Release of Information

Most student information provided to TRIO/SSS is protected by the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) and will not be released without the student's written permission. TRIO/SSS would like your permission to access and release family and student information for the following reasons:

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- 1. TRIO/SSS must report student academic progress and eligibility information to the U.S. Department of Education to demonstrate program effectiveness when requesting renewed funding.
- Scholarship agencies, leadership, internship, employment and educational programs contact TRIO/SSS to offer opportunities to participants. TRIO/SSS may release student information (grade summaries, letters of recommendation, etc.) to these entities. TRIO/SSS never sells lists of names or other student information.
- 3. Augsburg Student Financial Services will provide us eligibility and Financial Aid Award information.
- 4. Academic progress monitoring with faculty and instructional support staff for the purpose of students' continued academic success and possible intervention by program staff.
