WHAT IS TRIO/SSS SUMMER BRIDGE?

The Augsburg TRIO/Student Support Services
Summer Bridge program provides first-year, TRIO/
SSS-eligible students a smooth transition into their
Augsburg education in the fall. After Summer Bridge,
students continue to participate in TRIO/SSS while
enrolled at Augsburg.

WHY SUMMER BRIDGE?

Summer Bridge is a great way to begin your Auggie experience! As a Summer Bridge participant, you will:

- Complete two Augsburg courses for credit
- Live on campus in a residence hall
- Learn practical study skills that will help you throughout college
- Participate in seminars, workshops, and activities designed to engage you in the Augsburg and Minneapolis communities
- Begin college with classmates, staff, and faculty connections already in place

SUMMER BRIDGE COSTS

- There is no out-of-pocket cost for students[◊]
- Eligible students receive a four-year Summer Bridge Promise Grant

♦ Students must complete a 2025–26 FAFSA


PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY

Augsburg TRIO/SSS participants must be **U.S. citizens or permanent residents or refugees** pursuing their first bachelor's degree. Program participants must demonstrate **academic need** for services and **meet at least one** of the following criteria:

- First-generation college student: a student whose parents did not complete a bachelor's degree
- Low-income student: a student whose family meets federal income eligibility guidelines as verified by Augsburg University
- Student with documented disabilities: as defined in the Americans with Disabilities Act and verified by Augsburg's Center for Learning and Accessible Student Services

APPLICATION PROCESS

- 1. Be admitted to Augsburg University.
- 2. If you meet Summer Bridge eligibility criteria, you will receive a link to the application and be encouraged to apply.
- 3. Complete the **2026–27** Free Application for Federal Student Aid **and** complete the **2025–26** FAFSA to receive financial aid for Summer 2026.

DEADLINE

Apply for Summer Bridge 2026 by 1 p.m. Central Time, Friday, March 13, 2026.

TRIO/Student Support Services serves all program participants without regard to race, color, national or ethnic origin, age, disability, religious belief, gender, gender identity or expression, sexual orientation, or marital status.

Augsburg TRIO/SSS is funded with a grant from the U.S. Department of Education in the annual amount of \$306,511, or about 70% of the overall project funds. The remainder of project funding is contributed by Augsburg University for the successful implementation of the Student Support Services program.
