- 1. Approving Minutes
  - a. The minutes from October 15 were approved.
- 2. Governance Updates
  - a. President
    - Jim and Mark met with the President last Thursday. They discussed the Community Engagement Day. President Pribbenow suggested this happen in both the fall and spring.
    - ii. They thanked the President for the spot at the table at the Board of Regents meeting.
  - b. Leadership Council
    - i. Discussed innovation initiatives the Augsburg has done in the past 30 years in order to foster discussion around future innovation.
- 3. Committee Updates
  - a. Diversity & Inclusion
    - i. A diversity and inclusion survey was sent to every student on Monday, October 27. Please encourage your students to take it if they have not already.
  - b. Safety
    - i. Martha was absent at the last safety committee meeting.
    - ii. Another meeting is taking place next week.
  - c. IT
- i. We will take IT off of the agenda for future meetings, as Staff Senate does not have a reserved spot on this committee.
- d. College Resource Committee
  - i. Nothing to report.
- 4. Community Service Day
  - a. 7 people were in first shift; 9 people, in the second shift.
  - b. The major goal of the event should be giving opportunities to staff members to utilize their community service hours.
  - c. Spring date could happen during spring break, and we could extend the invitation to faculty, students, and alumni.
    - i. We settled on either Tuesday, March 17, or Thursday, March 19.
    - ii. Martha will check with Mary Laurel and Steve to see which date would work better.
- 5. Staff Appreciation Awards
  - a. Awards Nomination Process
    - i. We will move to a completely online nominations form. Mike will create this form and look over the wording.

- ii. The award submission window will be Monday, January 5 through Friday, February 13.
- iii. We will be meeting on Monday, February 23 to select the recipients of the awards.
- Martha will set a meeting time with her, Mike, Dulce, Seth, and Mark to discuss publicity
  of these awards.
- c. Mike will confirm the date of the Staff Appreciation Awards with Event and Conference Planning and the President.
- d. Mike will also research those who have won it in past years.
- 6. Social Choice Option in the Retirement Plan
  - a. Our new retirement plan option does not include a Social Choice option. Social Choice options have certain limits set on them that are considered "socially responsible," such as not funding big oil, big tobacco, etc.
  - Augsburg stopped providing it because they did not want to slow down the shift to our new options.
    - i. Human Resources has said they are looking into new Social Choice options.
  - c. Several staff members have said that they wanted it back because it aligns with Augsburg's mission of being socially responsible.
  - d. Kelly will write a letter to Dionne to let her know that we have received feedback around adding a new Social Choice option.
- 7. Connecting Alumni with Current Students in Mentorship Program
  - a. Institutional Advancement has a mentorship program called "Augsburg Builds Connections" (ABC Program) that connects students with alumni.
    - i. The program currently does not have a focus on retention. It is more focused on students who would like to have an alumni mentor.
    - ii. There are many alumni who want to be mentors, but there are not as many students who have requested wanting alumni.
    - iii. There are currently 27 partnerships.
- 8. Auggie Pride Awards
  - a. Individuals who do not win will be moved forward one month; if they do not receive it again, they will be contacted that they were nominated, did not receive it, but share their nomination.
  - b. Stephen Geffre and Sarah Griesse won for October.
    - i. Mark will contact the winners.
